



P E T I T I O N

We, the undersigned, petition East Sussex County Council to create a safe crossing point on High Street, Ticehurst (B2099), just below the junction with Pickforde Lane.

The escalating volume of traffic through Ticehurst on the B2099 has impacted heavily on residents, visitors and businesses within the village, and with the 30 mph restriction frequently thwarted, there have been many near misses as pedestrians attempt to cross to shop and to socialise.

Most supported housing and many family homes are sited to the north of the High Street, while the majority of the shops are sited to the south. This means that older people, many with access needs, have no choice but to negotiate the road to and from the shops each day, while families with pushchairs and small children are equally forced to take their lives in their hands when crossing.

Doing nothing until there is a major accident along this increasingly busy stretch of road is the wrong approach, and this petition calls for the Council to provide a crossing in Ticehurst centre to help keep our community safe.
